SunState Federal Credit Union worker arrested for grand theft

CHIEFLAND -- A SunState Federal Credit Union (of Chiefland) teller was arrested Tuesday (Sept. 19) after two audits showed \$7,300 missing from the cash drawer that was in her custody, according to records.

Rachel Lynn Mobley, 31, of Chiefland was arrested for grand theft, according to an incident report by arresting officer Chiefland Police Officer K. Schultz.

Branch Manager Carole Tucker said Mobley had been audited several times throughout the month, Schultz said. Audits reflected about \$7,300 missing from Mobley's drawer. Officer Schultz read the suspect the Miranda warning.

"Mobley stated that she was having financial difficulties," Schultz reported, "which is why she was taking the money. Mobley confessed that the approximate amount of \$7,300 was accurate."

Mobley was bonded out of the Levy County Jail on Oct. 20 and her bond was for \$30,000, according to records.
