Watermelons Sold

This famous stand in Levy County started its service to the public recently again this year. This is Corbin's eighth consecutive year at the stand, which is renowned for high quality watermelons and cantaloupes year after year. This covered stand is on U.S. Alt. 27 between Bronson and Levyville, near Levy County Road 124. Melba Tillis and her family sell the delicious, fresh watermelons grown by Murray Tillis and Terry Tillis, Melba's sons. These watermelons – both with and without seeds – are selling at \$5 each. On Saturday, Alvord bought many other vegetables, too. The available vegetables on Saturday morning at that stand included cucumbers, eggplant, squash, sweet corn, green tomatoes, bell peppers and Jalapeño peppers. Some vegetables sell out before a consumer reaches the stand to buy them. The best way to find out is to drop by and check it out.
